THE TRUE HEAVENLY MANDATE

Since the beginning of 2020 when COVID-19 became a pandemic, we've noticed one article on our web site that has received the most hits. It's entitled, *God's Destiny for China ~ The True Heavenly Mandate* and can be found in our 20th East Gates anniversary magazine. Actually, it doesn't surprise us since time immemorial, the Chinese have had a deep sense that the heavens and the earth were somehow inextricably connected in a very profound and mysterious way. Even today, in this world of information technology and artificial intelligence, the Chinese have an innate sense that the spiritual and physical realms are somehow intimately tied together. With all the chaos that has hit their nation, they're truly wondering what is the true Heavenly Mandate for China because human governments certainly don't seem to have the answer!

As we've shared before in our newsletter, there was a time in China's history (2nd millennium BC) when China was monotheistic and believed in one supreme God - Shang-Di, 上帝. All the emperors were considered *tianzi*, 天子, or "sons of heaven." Heaven, *tian*, was referred to as the "great whole." In actuality, they were far closer to the true reality than they are now.

When we share God's Word in China, we bring our students a Hebraic worldview and the true Heavenly Mandate their emperors and rulers all longed for but could never define. We reveal to them the true Shang-Di, who came forth in the fullness of time (Galatians 4:4) as Jesus Christ (*Yeshua* in Hebrew), to reveal the Kingdom of God. He is our Creator and our King who can live within us now. He is the one who breathed into us His breath of life and divine intellect. Unlike any other creature on the planet, humans were created to be "praying beings." Only we can develop an intimate relationship with our Creator. He gave us His instruction book, the Holy Bible, so we could learn of His nature, life-giving patterns, rhythm and moral order to life. That's what we've been sharing with our Chinese disciples online today.

The Chinese have always yearned for immortality. Given the onslaught of challenges facing China today ~ epic flooding, COVID-19, sandstorms, swine flu and economic woes...millions of Chinese are wondering deep down inside, why are the gods so angry? We point them to the one and only true God and feed them the right answers through God's Word.

Michael (far right) knew almost every major House church leader and would travel alongside them ministering throughout China.




Michael (far left) truly enjoyed becoming “one” with the local brethren. Here he is having a meal with Christian brothers in Yunnan Province.




Michael (center) had a talent for sensing the spiritual and physical needs of a church. Pastors often called upon our East Gates team to counsel them in these areas.
